Saddle Series 2019

RULES

1. Owners & Riders must be members of AZRCHA prior to the start of a show for points to count. Memberships paid at the show will count.
2. One horse - One Rider combination
3. Qualifying horse shows are:
 - SAHQA - January - 2 days
 - Sun Country Circuit - March - 3 days
 - Gilkerson Memorial - April - 2 days
 - Western States - June - 2 days
 - AZQHA Fall Championship - September - 2 days
4. Divisions are: Open, Non-Pro and Non-Pro Limited
5. All divisions will be run as a block.
 - Open block will consist of these classes:
 - Open Bridle, Open Hackamore & Open Two Rein
 - Non-Pro block will consist of these classes:
 - Novice, Intermediate & Non-Pro Bridle, Non-Pro Hackamore & Non-Pro Two Rein
 - Non-Pro Limited block will consist of these classes:
 - Non-Pro Limited & \$5K Non-Pro Limited
6. Exhibitor scores will be combined within the block and will be based on a 9 point scale.
7. Only one score per horse show will count. In the event that a class that is typically held concurrent is run separately, then the score from the Open Bridle, Open Hackamore, Non-Pro Bridle or the Non-Pro Limited will take precedence.
8. In the event of a tie, the highest total cow score from all shows will break the tie. Second tie breaker will be the highest total rein score from all shows.
